Guidelines For Mentors – Mentoring is considered to be one of the critical elements of the Culminating Project at Jurupa Hills High School. Each student must choose a mentor for his or her Project who will serve as a consultant throughout the experience. Although the role of the mentor may vary in each student-planned Project, the following are general statements regarding the role of the mentor within this Project.

Mentors serve as a resource for students and should have experience or expertise in the student's focus area.

Mentors verify the completion of the student work and hours.

Mentors are required to have a minimum of three (3) contacts with the mentee during the course of their interactive/hands-on experience (either summer or semester).

Mentors should contact the work site and/or person involved with supervising your mentee three (3) times – this can be done via telephone or email. If a student is working independently than obviously only the mentor/mentee meeting is needed.

Mentors should attempt to guide the student through the experience, to encourage different possibilities to solving problems, to model appropriate skills and knowledge, and to assist the
