Your child's class was selected to pilot a colored "clip chart" to improve students' behavior and choices. Students will have a "behavior clip" that they move up or down the clip chart depending on their choices. The goal of this new program is to keep our students on the green color letting us know that they are "Ready to Learn". Students that end the day on purple, "Superstar Status" will receive special class incentives at the end of the week. The chart below explains the clip chart colors and what each color means.

Purple	Students who model respectful, responsible, and safe behavior will "clip up" and move to PURPLE. Students who
Superstar	are on purple will receive special classroom incentives during class time and/or at the end of the day or week.
Blue	Students who show respectful, responsible, and safe
Great Choices	behavior will "clip up" and move to BLUE. Students who are on blue will receive special classroom incentives at the end of the day or the week.
Green Ready to Learn	Every student begins the day on GREEN. Students either stay on GREEN, " clip up," or " clip down," depending on their behavior.
Yellow I can make BETTER choices	Students will " clip down" to YELLOW when a warning has been given. This serves as an opportunity for students to stop and think about the choices they make.
Mustard	Students who continue to make inapropriate choices, will be moved down to MUSTARD. This will result in the
