 - If applicable, sign up for summer school to remediate courses for graduation or college eligibility (see counselor with questions).
 - Evaluate your Spring Semester grades and determine goals for your sophomore year.
 - Turn in all work and study for Semester 2 final exams. (All semester grades will be posted on your Kaiser High Transcript)

 - Attend Summer School to Remediate Courses (If Applicable) to remediate any classes you need for graduation or college requirements.
